### **Farewell to Fr. Ambrose**

Fr. Ambrose Maliakka I.C., who has been parish priest of our neighbouring parish of St. Joseph's for the last few years, is leaving the parish to take up new responsibilities in India. There will be a farewell Mass for Fr. Ambrose on Monday evening at 7pm to which all are welcome. Canon Isaac will be preaching at the Mass. We wish Fr. Ambrose the best for his future ministry and welcome Fr. Justus Okibo I.C. who has been appointed as parish priest of St. Joseph's.

### **November – The Month of the Holy Souls**

During the month of November, we will pray for the Faithful Departed at Mass every day. We will remember especially those included on the Holy Souls' lists in both Churches. Envelopes are at the back of both Churches for your Holy Souls' lists.

### **All Saints**

Thursday, the Solemnity of All Saints, is a Holyday of Obligation on which all Catholics are expected to attend Mass. There are five Masses here in the parish: a Vigil Mass at 7pm on Wednesday evening at Our Lady of Lourdes and Masses at 10am and 7pm on Thursday at St. Teilo's. In addition, there are Masses in Polish on Thursday at Our Lady of Lourdes at 10am and 6pm.

### **The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls)**

On Friday, we commemorate all those who have died and are on the journey to heaven. The Church's tradition is that each priest may say three Masses on this day. Masses in the parish will be at 10am and 7pm in St. Teilo's and at 12pm midday at Our Lady of Lourdes. There are also Polish Masses on Friday at Our Lady of Lourdes at 10am and 7pm.

### **Plenary Indulgence for the Faithful Departed**

A plenary indulgence, applicable to the souls in Purgatory, is granted when you visit a church on November 2nd. While visiting the church or oratory, you are required to say one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed in addition to the other requirements for a plenary indulgence - to have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins (one confession will cover a number of indulgences); receive the Holy Eucharist; and pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

A partial indulgence may be obtained by visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed on any day from the 1st to the 8th of November. (A plenary indulgence can be gained by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1st and November 8th.)

## **First Friday Coffee Morning and Cake Sale**

Friday, November 2nd, is the first Friday of the month. The 10am Mass at St. Teilo's will be followed by a coffee morning. Why not come along to share coffee, tea, good conversation and a raffle? Linda, Pat and the team, who have previously provided cakes and pasties at Our Lady of Lourdes' coffee mornings, will be holding their cake sale during the St. Teilo's coffee morning.

The candle burning in front of the Book of Remembrance this week is for the repose of the souls of Gornald and Janet Parsons. May they and all the faithful departed rest in peace.

## **Mass for the Travelling Community – Next Sunday**

One of the four priests who act as chaplains to the Travelling Community in England and Wales will be saying Mass next Sunday at Our Lady of Lourdes at 5pm. Though the Mass is targeted at the large number of members of the Travelling Community here in Cardiff, it is, of course, open to all who wish to attend.

## **November Requiem Masses**

On Saturday, November 10th at 11am, we will have a Requiem Mass for all the departed whose funerals have been held in the parish during the last year. Everyone is invited to come along and remember the deceased of the parish. On Sunday, November 11th, the 11am Mass will be a Requiem to pray for the dead of the First World War on the 100th Anniversary of the Armistice, the end of the war. Active or former military persons are invited to wear their uniform should they wish. Following this, Canon Isaac will bless the graves at the Pantmawr Cemetery.
