Parish Requiem Mass

On Saturday, November 10th at 11am, we will have a Requiem Mass for all the departed whose funerals have been held in the parish during the last year. Everyone is invited to come along and remember the deceased of the parish.

Requiem Mass for all those who have died in War

At 11am on the eleventh day of the eleventh month, in 1918, World War One ended after four years and four months. On this day, Germany signed an armistice with Britain and France. Since 1919, this day has been marked as Remembrance Day, a day to remember and pray for the dead of the First World War and all those who have died in war since that time.

On Sunday, November 11th, 100 years after the end of the war, the parish 11am Mass will be a Requiem Mass to pray for all those who have died in war and to join in spirit with those who gather at the Cenotaph in Whitehall and at all the memorials across the country to pray for those who gave their lives to keep our country safe. Active and former military personnel are invited to wear their uniform if they so wish.

Blessing of deceased parishioners' graves

After the 11am Mass next Sunday, Canon Isaac will proceed to Pantmawr Cemetery to bless the graves of our deceased parishioners who are buried there and to pray for all the deceased members of our parish and our families.
