Requiem Mass for all those who have died in War

At 11am on the eleventh day of the eleventh month, in 1918, World War One ended after four years and four months. On this day, Germany signed an armistice with Britain and France. Since 1919, this day has been marked as Remembrance Day, a day to remember and pray for the dead of the First World War and all those who have died in war since that time.

Today, 100 years after the end of the war, the Parish 11am Mass will be a Requiem Mass to pray for all those who have died in War. We will remember them!

Coffee and tea will be served upstairs in the Hall after the 9am and the 11am Masses. All are welcome.

Blessing of deceased parishioners' graves

After the 11am Mass Canon Isaac will proceed to Pantmawr Cemetery to bless the graves of our deceased parishioners who are buried there and to pray for all the deceased members of our parish and our families.

Rest in Peace - Please pray for the repose of the soul of Fr. Michael Cronin, a priest of the Archdiocese who died recently at Nazareth House. Father Cronin's body will be received into Nazareth House on Thursday, November 15th at 4.30pm. His Requiem Mass will take place on Friday, November 16th in Nazareth House at 12 noon. His body will then be taken to Llantarnam Abbey for burial at 2.30pm.

Memorial Candle - The candle burning in front of the Book of Remembrance this week is for the repose of the souls of the deceased members of the Bergonzi Family. May they and all the faithful departed rest in peace.

Archbishop's Letter

My Dear People

The annual collection for the support of the sick and retired clergy of the Archdiocese will be taken over the weekend of November 17th/18th. This fund ensures our priests receive the best care and support they deserve when they retire or fall ill after a lifetime of service in our parishes, schools, hospitals and other chaplaincies.

Whilst most people retire in their mid to later 60's, priests generally step down from the responsibilities of being parish priests at the age of 75. Even after this, many of our priests continue in some form of active ministry – celebrating Mass where needed, supporting parish life, offering counsel and support to those in need and, above all, praying for the needs of all. Others simply become very old, too frail or incapacitated but none are forgotten either by their former parishioners or the Archdiocese of Cardiff.

Your donations to this important collection ensure a dignified retirement for all of our priests. Your support helps cover gaps in health care or health emergencies as well as providing care for those with chronic conditions or those who are disabled. Please contribute generously if you are able. By completing a Gift Aid envelope, taxpayers can add 25% to your donation at no cost to yourself. Envelopes for this purpose are available today.

Forty Hours' Devotion - Quarant'Ore - The Forty Hours' Devotion is a special 40-hour period of prayer made before the Blessed Sacrament in solemn Exposition. A Church tradition since the 1500s, it takes place each year at the University Chaplaincy, Nazareth House. This year it runs from Friday, November 23rd to Sunday, November 25th. On Friday, adoration begins with Mass at 6pm and continues to midnight. Adoration continues from 8am on Saturday through to 7pm on Sunday. You are welcome to spend as much or as little time in prayer before the Blessed Sacrament during the period.
