The Mass readings and prayers for the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time are on page 127.

The Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity

This weekend is part of the Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity, which lasts until the Feast of the Conversion of St. Paul on Friday. This year, the Octave focuses on the context of ethnic and religious diversity, where there is a strong emphasis upon the need for a unity that is found in diversity and one built on solidarity and collaboration. It highlights issues of economic injustice and how religious pluralism can face challenges in the face of radicalisation. We pray for an end to harm and hurt and for collaboration between Christians for the greater glory of God. Here in the parish, the highlight of our Christian Unity engagement is our Mass this evening at 6.30pm. The Mass will be celebrated by the Archbishop and will be sung by the choral scholars of the Llandaff Cathedral School, led by Mr Timothy Hill, their Director, and the other staff of the School. We welcome His Grace and the Choristers to St. Teilo's.

Ordinary Time

Today we begin the 'Ordinary Time' of the Church's Year. This period, which in Latin is called: *tempus per annum* (otherwise translated as time during the year), is the period between the Baptism of the Lord and the start of Lent. Ash Wednesday is on March 6th. Today, the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Gospel continues to centre on the manifestation of the Lord, which Epiphany celebrated, through the traditional passage about the wedding feast at Cana. From next Sunday, we begin a semi-continuous reading of the Gospel of Luke with its focus on the healing and teaching ministry of the Lord.
