**4. Safeguarding - Update**

Gerry reported that the follow up of the Internet Safety Seminar on Tuesday, March 27<sup>th</sup> was not as well attended as the first one. However there had been enough people to proceed. The new law of GDP Regulations was discussed and whether someone should be appointed to deal with this issue. Canon suggested that it was better to wait and see how the Archdiocese will deal with this issue.

**7. Evangelisation at St Teilo's**

**Invite-a-Friend on Adoremus Sunday, July 1st**

By agreement with Archbishop George and Bishop Burns of Menevia, parishes across Cardiff and Menevia are asked to make Sunday, July 1<sup>st</sup> a special day when parishioners invite a friend to come and experience Sunday Mass. It was agreed that this event should be moved to a later date due to the fact that Deacon David Prichard is to be ordained for the Ordinariate on Saturday, June 30<sup>th</sup>. Fr (as he will be on that date) David is going to celebrate his First Mass at St Teilo's at 6.30pm on Sunday, July 1<sup>st</sup>.
