## **Major Christian Unity Event in Dinas Powys**

Over the Spring Bank Holiday weekend, May 24th to 26th, at Hebron Hall in Dinas Powys, a wide range of people from Wales and England will focus on some of the most challenging words in the Gospel: "May they all be one" (Jn.17:21). How can we live these words of Jesus? In a world full of divisions, how can we both respect diversity and live unity when we come from different backgrounds, cultures and beliefs? The weekend is organised by the Focolare Movement. People of all ages, backgrounds and cultures will come together to put into practice the universal values of the Christian Gospel. The emphasis is on learning to live in mutual love, based on the Golden Rule (Lk 6:31) - to treat others as we would like them to treat us. The Focolare Movement has been involved in dialogue, especially interdenominational and interfaith conversations, for many years.
