### Pentecost Sunday

Today we celebrate Pentecost Sunday, the day on which the Holy Spirit inspired the Apostles to go out and proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit is still with the Church and He inspires each one of us anew today to proclaim the message of Jesus to a world that needs His presence and His love.

The candle burning in front of the Book of Remembrance this week is for the repose of the souls of the Wallworth and Prendergast families. May they, and all the faithful departed, rest in peace.

### Mary, Mother of the Church

On Monday of this week, we celebrate Mary, Mother of the Church. St. Pope Paul the Sixth proclaimed Mary under the title of Mother of the Church on November 21st 1964 and decreed that this title should be added to the Litany of Our Lady and other devotions. He said that, "the Mother of God should be further honoured and invoked by the entire Christian people by this tenderest of titles – Mother of the Church".

Last year, Pope Francis added this memorial to the Roman Calendar for the whole Church. The decree celebrating the memorial says: "Having attentively considered how greatly the promotion of this devotion might encourage the growth of the maternal sense of the Church in the pastors, religious and faithful, as well as a growth of genuine Marian piety, Pope Francis has decreed that the Memorial of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church, should be inscribed in the Roman Calendar on the Monday after Pentecost and be now celebrated every year. This celebration will help us to remember that growth in the Christian life must be anchored to the Mystery of the Cross, to the oblation of Christ in the Eucharistic Banquet and to the Mother of the Redeemer and Mother of the Redeemed, the Virgin who makes her offering to God."

## **Adoration for Our Families**

On Monday of this week, June 10th, we have the monthly hour of adoration for families here at St. Teilo's between 1.30pm and 2.30pm. Families face many challenges in our society. This monthly adoration before the Blessed Sacrament is an opportunity to pray for our families and the problems that they face. All are welcome to attend this time of quiet prayer.

## **Making A Difference – Meeting on Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at St. Brigid's**

On Tuesday, June 18th at 7pm at St. Brigid's Hall you will have the opportunity to attend an informal meeting explaining how to make a personal gift or legacy to the Archdiocese. You may have come across the brochure called, A Gift to Our Church. Starting with a message from Archbishop George, the booklet includes details of where the Archdiocese has existing commitments but also, in the case of training new priests, a vision for the future. Archbishop George explains, "To make a gift, especially a bequest, is a very personal and private act of generosity and we want to ensure that we meet the wishes of the donor... My message to any parishioner who is thinking of making a gift, of any type, is please speak to your Parish Priest or if you would prefer, directly to me. We can establish your wishes and take all necessary steps to ensure that these wishes are met."

Gifts to the Archdiocese have in fact made an enormous contribution to churches across all of the region. The Gift to Our Church brochure highlights just some of the good work already underway, including our commitment to seminarians and retired clergy. The meeting will be an opportunity to meet staff from Archbishop's House to discuss how to make a personal bequest or a gift in memory of a loved one. For those who are interested, the Archdiocese will be making available expertise in this area, including solicitors who can assist with the drafting of a will.
