(d) To rediscover and renew our understanding of overseas mission (missio ad gentes). We will continue to reflect on the mission of the Church throughout the month.

World Mission Sunday is the Sunday in the year when the entire global Church comes together in support of mission. This year Pope Francis has declared the theme of the year as "Baptised and Sent: The Church of Christ on Mission in the World." World Mission Sunday is our chance to show love and solidarity to our family in faith throughout the world. Through our prayers, we support missionaries everywhere in spreading the Good News.
