All Saints - Holyday of Obligation

Friday, the Solemnity of All Saints, is a Holyday of Obligation on which all Catholics are expected to attend Mass. There will be a Vigil Mass at 7pm on Thursday evening at Our Lady of Lourdes and Masses at 10am and 7pm on Friday at St. Teilo's.

First Friday Coffee Morning

Friday, November 1st is the First Friday of the month so there will be a Coffee Morning after the 10am Mass at St. Teilo's.

The Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls)

On Saturday, we commemorate all those who have died and are on the journey to heaven. Mass on All Souls will be at 10am at St. Teilo's.

First Saturday Devotions

We continue the First Saturday devotions at St. Teilo's next Saturday. Those who wish to take part are asked to gather at 9.30am in the Church to recite the Rosary and pray the Fatima prayers. Leaflets will be provided. Why not come along to respond to Our Lady's call to pray for the world in all its turmoil and need?

Plenary Indulgence for the Faithful Departed

A plenary indulgence, applicable to the souls in Purgatory, is granted when you visit a church on November 2nd. While visiting the church or oratory, you are required to say one Our Father and the Apostles' Creed in addition to the other requirements for a plenary indulgence - to have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins (one confession will cover a number of indulgences); receive the Holy Eucharist and pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.

A partial indulgence may be obtained by visiting a cemetery and praying for the departed on any day from November 1st to the 8th. A plenary indulgence can be gained by visiting a cemetery each day between November 1st and November 8th.

November – The Month of the Holy Souls

During the month of November, we will pray for the Faithful Departed at Mass every day. We will remember especially those included on the Holy Souls' lists in both Churches. Envelopes and sheets for your family Holy Souls' list are available at the back of both Churches. They can be handed in to the sacristy, dropped into the presbytery or placed in the collection plate.

November – Grave Lights

Candles are available at the back of the Church to take home or to the graves of loved ones. These candles, sometimes called Grave Lights, remind us of the light of Christ and ask that the Lord Jesus brings our loved ones home to His kingdom of light. The Grave Lights cost £3 each. Please place the money for them in the candle boxes in the Church

November – Requiem Mass for those who have died recently

On Saturday, November 9th at 10am, we will have a Requiem Mass for all the departed whose funerals have been held in the parish during the last year. Everyone is invited to come along and remember the deceased of the parish.

November – Remembrance Sunday

On Sunday, November 10th, the 11am Mass will be a Requiem to pray for those who have died in war. Following this Mass, Canon Isaac will bless the graves at the Pantmawr Cemetery.

November – A Time to Remember
