Mass on Friday will be at the slightly earlier time of 9am to enable Canon to attend the Archdiocesan Commission for Christian Unity which takes place later that morning.

November – The Month of the Holy Souls

As I mentioned last weekend, I hope that we can all make November a special time for prayer for the Holy Souls. We pray for our own families and friends and those who helped us in life but we also need to remember all the departed, especially those who have no one on earth left to pray for them. During the month of November, we will pray for the Faithful Departed at Mass every day. We will remember especially those included on the Holy Souls' lists in both Churches. Envelopes and sheets for your family's Holy Souls' list are available at the back of both Churches. They can be handed in to the sacristy, dropped into the presbytery or placed in the collection plate.

As Catholics, let us reclaim our wonderful November tradition as a positive time, a prayerful and hope-filled time. We need to recapture the rightful theme of the triumph of all those in heaven, the living witness of all the Saints down the ages and the real message of the month of the Holy Souls – nothing to do with ghosts and fantasies, but everything to do with the triumph of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ over death and hell.

November – Requiem Mass for those who have died recently

On Saturday, November 9th at 10am, we will have a Requiem Mass for all the departed whose funerals have been held in the parish during the last year. Everyone is invited to come along and remember the deceased of the parish.

November – Remembrance Sunday

Next Sunday, November 10th we will pray for all of the departed who lost their lives as a result of the inhumanity of war. The 11am Mass will begin with the two minute silence and will be a Requiem Mass for the dead of all wars. Stuart Hanger, a parishioner, who served in the military, will lay the Parish Poppy Wreath. Donations to the Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal can be made in the box at the back of the Church. Following this Mass, Canon Isaac will bless the graves at the Pantmawr Cemetery.
