### Antiphons for Today's Mass

### Weekday Mass - no need to book

We continue with the pattern of celebrating Mass at St. Teilo's at 10am each day. Masses from Monday to Saturday morning do not need to be pre-booked.

### Sunday Masses

The Parish has three Sunday Masses, the Vigil Mass at 6pm on Saturday, the 10am Mass on Sunday morning and a 6pm Mass on Sunday evening.

Click on the red 'Select a date' button and select the date and time of the Mass you wish to attend. You can book for Masses for future weeks too. Booking closes 17 hours before the start of Mass.

## Attending Mass

Whichever Mass you attend, you will need to abide by the following restrictions.

- You will only attend Mass if you are able to confirm that you currently show no symptoms of Covid-19.
- You will wear a face-covering/mask in Church at all times, except to receive Holy Communion.
- You should arrive between 20 and 5 minutes before the start time of Mass.
- You must wait for the door steward to confirm your attendance and for Sunday Masses, tell you the seat to which you have been allocated.
- You will use the temperature check on entering the Church.
- You will use hand-sanitiser as you enter and exit the Church.
- Please allow a Steward to show you to your seat.
- **Please do not leave your seat to go and talk to other parishioners who are not part of your household/bubble.**
- Please wait to be invited up to Holy Communion.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has confirmed that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended. So please do not feel under any pressure to attend the Church when online or phone Masses are valid alternatives.

## Chasing the Wind: The Bible, Philosophy, and the Problem of Evil

Dr. Gregory Stacey of the Diocese of Leeds will be leading five talks on Zoom between 7 and 8pm from Monday June 14<sup>th</sup> for five weeks.

He will address the questions:

- Does the extent and variety of evil make belief in God irrational?
- Have philosophers provided convincing responses to the "argument from evil"?
- Can the Christian story help us to make sense of suffering?

The five talks will introduce accessible answers to these questions, in dialogue with Biblical texts.
