### Farewell and welcome

In the bittersweet ways of life this week, we in the parish are sad as we say farewell to one priest and are filled with hope as we welcome another.

We say farewell to Fr. Dwayne, who leaves St. Teilo's after Mass on Tuesday evening to return to his diocese in Poland. We will remember him and his great joy in life and the faith, for many years to come. On behalf of the parish, we would like to thank Fr. Dwayne for his care for Canon Isaac through the last months of his life and for his help to all of us, as a parish, to mourn with dignity for our former Parish Priest and begin the journey to the next stage of our parish's life.

On Wednesday, we welcome Canon John Griffiths, who would like to be known as Fr. John, as our new Parish Priest, to lead us in faith in the years ahead. Fr. John will celebrate Mass at 7pm on Wednesday evening.

### Sunday Masses

The Parish has three Sunday Masses, the Vigil Mass at 6pm on Saturday, the 10am Mass on Sunday morning and a 6pm Mass on Sunday evening. Bookings for all three Sunday Masses should be made via the parish's online booking service - <https://www.eventbrite.co.uk/e/holy-mass-at-st-teilos-church-whitchurch-cardiff-tickets-114153754954> . Click on the red 'Select a date' button and select the date and time of the Mass you wish to attend. You can book for Masses for future weeks too. Booking closes 17 hours before the start of Mass.

### Holyday of Obligation – St. Peter and St. Paul

While the obligation to attend Mass is currently suspended. Tuesday this week is the Solemnity of St. Peter and St. Paul. If you intend to attend Mass on Tuesday, you should book via the Parish Online Booking Service, link above. Masses that day will be at 10am and 7pm. The 10am Mass is likely to be full, but the Evening Mass has less bookings, so if you forget to book and want to attend Mass, please come along to the Evening Mass.

### **Weekday Mass Times – Small change**

From this week and for the foreseeable future, Mass on Wednesday at St. Teilo's will be celebrated at 7pm. Mass will continue at 10am on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday. There is no need to book to attend weekday Mass.

### **Receiving Holy Communion at Mass**

From Wednesday onwards, we will revert to receiving Communion at the traditional time during Mass. This will involve a change in the stewarding process as stewards will now not only direct you to Communion, but also assist in your return to your seat after Communion. Stewards will also direct you to leave the Church at the end of Mass. **Please follow the directions of the stewards and do not leave your seat at the end of Mass until invited to do so by the stewards.**

Due to the need for extra sanitation before and after Communion on the tongue, please notify the stewards if you wish to receive the Blessed Sacrament on the tongue. Fr. John will return to the sanctuary after Mass to give communion to those who wish to receive on the tongue.

A meeting for stewards will take place after Mass on Saturday evening, in order to go through the new processes.

### **Attending Mass**

Whichever Mass you attend, you will need to abide by the following restrictions.

- You will only attend Mass if you are able to confirm that you currently show no symptoms of Covid-19.
- You will wear a face-covering/mask in Church at all times, except to receive Holy Communion.
- You should arrive between 20 and 5 minutes before the start time of Mass.
- You must wait for the door steward to confirm your attendance and for Sunday Masses, tell you the seat to which you have been allocated.
- You will use the temperature check on entering the Church.
- You will use hand-sanitiser as you enter and exit the Church.
- Please allow a Steward to show you to your seat.
- **Please do not leave your seat to go and talk to other parishioners who are not part of your household/bubble.**
- Please wait to be invited up to Holy Communion and to leave the Church at the end of Mass.

The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has confirmed that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass remains suspended. So please do not feel under any pressure to attend the Church when online or phone Masses are valid alternatives.
