Synodal Process – The National Synthesis

Following the receipt of the Diocesan Synodal Reports, the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales formed a National Synthesis Team to draw up a document reflecting the views of the Church throughout England and Wales. The team met with diocesan representatives, including two of our parishioners, Madeleine Walters and Gill Kane, to gather feedback on the initial draft. The team, led by the General Secretary of the Bishops' Conference has reviewed all of the comments that were made on the day and have incorporated them where appropriate. She was Chair for 21 years and has recently stood down from her role while continuing as a Parish Council member. His Grace also wishes to acknowledge Madeleine's contribution to the wider work of the Archdiocese in her roles as Chair of the Diocesan Evangelisation Commission and as the lead of the Synodal Team for the Archdiocesan Synodal Process.

The Church's Social Outreach

Many thanks for the wonderful response to the request for Outreach volunteers at both St. Teilo's and Our Lady of Lourdes.

The next stage of the process is to identify who is interested in which aspect of the Outreach work. Initially we will have two programmes, a knitting/crochet group producing blankets for various places overseas and a parish project which is linked to the work the St. Vincent De Paul Society is doing in their St. Vincent's Centre at Ely Bridge.

The names of those who volunteered are on sheets at the back of the Church. Your name will be in the Church where you signed in, so if you move between St. Teilo's and Our Lady of Lourdes, it will help if you can remember where you signed in! Please indicate in which aspect of the work you are interested by putting the code from the list below beside your name. You are welcome to be involved in more than one area, in which case, put both codes in the space provided.

The simple code is as follows:

K – Knitting/crochet

P – Packing – Packing food parcels ready for distribution at the SVP base in Ely.

D – Delivering – Driving and delivering food parcels in the local/parish area.

ST – Steering Team – being part of the Team organising the Parish Outreach programme

F – Fundraiser – raising funds to support the work of outreach

I – Intercessors – committing to weekly prayers to support the outreach programme – this will be particularly welcome if you are not able to be involved in any other way

Sheets for new volunteers to sign are also at the back of the Church.

Pilgrimage of the Relics of St. John Lloyd and St. Philip Evans

This visit, postponed during the Covid pandemic, is scheduled to take place from July 11th to the 13th. During the recent meeting of the Conference of Bishops of England and Wales in Cardiff, the bishops visited the cell in Cardiff Castle where the two martyrs were imprisoned. They were moved to hear the story of heroism and faith displayed by Philip Evans and John Lloyd and were moved to pray before the statues of the saints. The three days will be celebrated as follows:
