Children's Liturgy – Summer Break

The Children's Liturgy at the 10am Mass on Sundays will not be meeting in the summer. Children's Liturgy will recommence at the 10am Mass on Sunday, September 11th.

Fundraising for the Society for the Protection of Unborn Children (SPUC)

The SPUC Senior Leadership team, made up of the Chief Executive John Deighan, and two Executive Directors, Michael Robinson and Matthew McCusker, are climbing the UK's highest mountain, Ben Nevis, on August 8th, to raise awareness and fundraise to protect unborn children and their parents. Baptism – Next Saturday

Next Saturday at St. Teilo's at 12.30pm, Fr. John will celebrate the Baptism of Artur Ostrikov. Baby Artur was born while in transit from Ukraine to Wales where he, his mother and elder siblings are now refugees living with a non-Catholic family here in the parish. Artur's father remains in Ukraine fighting for his homeland and hopes to join the Baptism by webcam and/or mobile phone.

It would be nice if any parishioners who were available could attend the Baptism on Saturday to support this family, who are new to our community, and respond to the prayers of the Baptism which will be in a language unfamiliar to the family. We welcome Artur into the community and we pray especially for him and his whole family and those who have agreed to be his godparents as they commit themselves to supporting Artur in his developing faith.

The first meeting of the Parish 'Reaching Out' Steering Group took place last Wednesday. The meeting began the planning process in preparing for the parishes' support for the project which will begin in September. The Steering Group is made up of Fr. On Tuesday evening, 7pm - 9pm, there will be Open Church in the Cathedral - inviting people into the Cathedral to light a candle, say a prayer and maybe have a chat. You are invited and are very welcome to participate in this Mission. You can do all of it, one day or a part or parts of a day. Archdiocesan Thanksgiving Mass for Marriage – New date

The Archdiocesan Thanksgiving Mass for Marriage was originally scheduled for May, but with the change of Archbishop, it was decided that it would be rescheduled. The new date is Saturday, October 1st at 12 noon. On that date Archbishop Mark will celebrate a Thanksgiving Mass for all the married couples of our Archdiocese. All are welcome. No invitations are needed, though an idea of numbers will help with catering. Those unable to attend in person can join via live-streaming, and during the Mass, married couples will be invited to make a Renewal of Commitment. There will be Refreshments in the Cornerstone after Mass.

The celebration is for all couples wishing to celebrate their marriage; whether you are celebrating a milestone anniversary this year, or because this year's anniversary will be significant because of specific life experiences (e.g. first child, first-time empty-nesters, following a particular challenge in their relationship, or any private significance) or simply to give thanks.

We would like to include as many anniversaries as possible in the Mass booklet and also to produce a reflective presentation compiled of your wedding photos which would be projected during the reception after Mass.
